Constable's Corner

Burglaries to motor vehicles continue to be a problem in the area. Please remember to lock your vehicles when you leave them unattended. A thief finds it easy when he can simply open the door of a vehicle to take what he/she wants. Park vehicles well up into the driveway. Remove any purses, wallets, CD cases, expensive sunglasses, etc. A vehicle parked against the curb also makes an easy target for the casual thief.

Bicycles should be locked or secured in the garage/house/apartment when not being used. Several bicycles were stolen last month. None were secured by locks. I was able to recover the bicycles and filed charges on the thieves the same day.

Remember crime prevention and reporting is a community neighborhood responsibility. If you know your neighbors and what types of vehicles they drive, the more likely you will notice something unusual.
