Dear Valued Customer:

Hurricane season is upon us and as a valued Waste Management customer, we wanted to take the time to inform you of our operational procedures in the event of a hurricane.

At Waste Management, it is imperative that we protect the health and safety of our employees, while at the same time insure that your business receives the level of service that is needed in the days before and after a hurricane. We cannot predict the severity of any storm, yet we can set expectation levels and provide the best communication possible throughout a severe weather event to ensure your operations have adequate waste collection and disposal.

The company encourages all businesses to secure their trash containers and if possible, place them in a safe location a day or two before an expected hurricane. In addition, all loose trash, such as boxes, pallets, etc. should be tied down and placed in a location where the debris cannot become a hazard to nearby homes, automobiles and citizens during high winds. If local authorities announce a mandatory evacuation for your area, your waste collection will be suspended on the day of the evacuation. This is to ensure the safety of our employees and to allow them enough time to evacuate the area as well. If there is no evacuation, yet waste collection is made impossible due to other conditions, you will be notified by your local sales representative.

After the storm, Waste Management will restart garbage and trash collection in areas that are deemed safe by local authorities and on streets that do not pose a hazard to our employees and/or our equipment. The company will expand its routes to additional areas as more streets become clear of debris and other impediments.
